Sir,

The Managing Director,M.T.D.C.Ltd.,Bombay vide his letter NO.MTDC.ETA TE/60183/YH,dt.22.3.1988 has informed us that the Youth Hostel,Aurangabad is transferred under the Administrative control of the Directorate of Sports and Youth Services,Pune,alongwith the staff,w.e.f. 1st April'88. It has also informed that the Warden,Youth Hostel Aurangabad will prepare a list of all documents,equipments,Dead Stock Articles,Furniture,T.V.Set etc; and submit the same to this Office and to the Director of Sports and Youth Services Pune,Managing Director,MTDC Bombay and the Government in Social Welfare,Cultural Affairs,Sports and Tourism,MS - Bombay in token of the Youth Hostel being transferred to the Directorate of Sports and Youth Services,Pune w.e.f. 1st April,1988.

2. The Bank account to be kept open till all the liabilities upto 31st March,88 are honoured.The Head Accountant of this Office will verify the said account record and then close the bank account by transferring the balance amount to the Head Office,M.T.D.C.Bombay .The Head Accountant will also undertake Audit of pending years and prepare income and expenditure statement accordingly.

3. As regards Civil Work,the Chief Engineer,MTDC Bombay will complete the balance work accordingly.

You are,therefore,requested to do the needful in this matter.

Dear

As you are aware the Scheme of Youth Hostels was launched with a view to promote youth travel and to provide cheap hostelling facilities to young persons when they go on educational tours, excursions, visit to historical and cultural centres.

2. The construction of Youth Hostels by the Government is a joint venture between the centre and State Governments. While the Central Government bears the cost of construction of the Youth Hostel, State Government provides developed piece of land free of cost with connection of water, electricity, approach road and staff quarters. The Youth Hostels are handed over to the State Governments for management. As per the Scheme the State Governments bears the responsibility of maintenance and minor repairs.

3. It has been observed that the State Governments are not taking adequate interests in the proper maintenance of youth Hostels and also minor repairs. Reports from various Youth Hostels have been received that the State Governments do not provide funds for this purpose.

4. As already stated the Youth Hostel Scheme is a joint venture between the Centre and State Governments, it is necessary that expenditure on maintenance and minor repairs, etc. of the Youth Hostels should be met by the State Government. It is requested that necessary steps in this regard may be taken by the State Government.
